Sun Safety

The weather this week has been warm and sunny. Please remember to keep your child safe in school in the sun by ensuring they have the following;

[] Filled water bottle in school daily (plain water ONLY, no juice or flavoured water)

A sun cap to wear outside

□ Applied sun cream before school. Children can also bring a labelled bottle if they stay all day and need to reapply at lunchtime.
□ Appropriate clothing (no vests or backless dresses, please ensure your child wears a t-shirt)

Appropriate and safe foot wear (no open toe shoes or Crocs please)

If your child arrives at school in clothes unsuitable we have a bag full of spare for them to borrow including skirts, leggings, school t shirts and jumper. Thank you
